



KDKC Supplemental Regulations Bulletin 2-15  
June 23, 2015

Revision to section 1.11 Series Championship Points System  
Section 1.11 in the KDKC 2015 Supplemental Regulations is replaced with the following effective June 12, 2015.

### **1.11 Series Championship Points System**

Race days will be run with practice, two heat races and a final. Points will be awarded based on the competitors finishing positions in the heat races and the final as outlined in [Appendix C](#). To score any points, a driver must be classified as a race finisher or Did Not Finish (DNF).

If an event that forms part of the Championship schedule is run with a qualifying, pre-final and final format championship points will be assigned as follows,

- Qualifying order = Heat 1 points
- Pre-final results = Heat 2 points
- Final results = Final points

All race days will have as a maximum 160 championship points available.

In determining the finishing position of each club member for the purpose of assigning championship points, the finishing positions of all non-members will be disregarded.

[For example, if a club member finishes second and a non-member wins the race, the club member will be awarded the championship points applicable to first place.]

Scoring for stopped races will be in accordance with the Canadian Karting Regulations Book 1, Sporting Regulations issued by ASN Canada FIA. KDKC Championship points will be assigned for stopped events as follows;

1. If a class is unable to complete their Final, competitors will be scored double points for each heat race result.
2. If a class is unable to complete their second heat, competitors will be scored full race day points based on Heat 1 results.
3. If *all classes* do not complete Heat 1 the event will be considered cancelled with no championship points awarded for any classes.

Upon technical inspection, should it be determined that there has been a blatant contravention of the technical regulations, the participant is subject to penalties that includes the possibility of exclusion and the loss of accumulated points in the class championship and other such penalties as are deemed appropriate by Kawartha Durham Kart Club.

A driver, who first races in a class as a member of the club, in either of the last 2 races of the season will not score or accumulate championship points in that class.

Championship points will be posted on the Kawartha Durham Kart Club website [www.kawarthadurhamkartclub.com](http://www.kawarthadurhamkartclub.com). Drivers/Entrants are responsible for checking their points standing and notifying the club in writing of any errors. Unless the error results from an unresolved appeal, the club will not be obliged to correct any errors that are notified after the earlier of, 30 days after the date of the event or October 20, 2015.
