WHAT STUFF DO I NEED?

Kart and Engine

Many different chassis manufacturers to choose from.
2-stroke or 4-stroke engine.

Kart Stand

Best way to work on your kart and move it around the paddock.

Tires and rims

Slick tires for dry days
Rain tires for wet days (yes, we race in the rain).

Pit Equipment

Carpet or cardboard for asphalt protection.
Basic set of tools. Most karts are in Metric.
Small air canister to fill tires.
Air pressure gauge.
Tie wraps.
Cleaners and lubricants.
Rags or shop towels.
Fuel cans and funnels

Extra Parts for your Kart.

Brake pads, springs.
Exhaust packing or tape.
Nuts and bolts.

Suit

Slip resistant, one piece kart specific.
Doesn't have to be fire resistant.

Helmet

Full face
Snell approved - Snell 2000 or better

Shoes

Running shoes work well, preferably without visible laces.

Rib Protector

Lots of bouncing around in the seat. This will protect your sides.

Neck Brace

Helps to support head and helmet.

Gloves

Good pair of motocross or racing gloves.
